

Obituary

"Let the work that I've done speak for me."

Pastor Calvin C. Jeffries was born on March 3, 1917 in Whiteville, NC to Effie and Sam Jeffries. He departed this life on September 1, 2014. On October 16, 1937 Calvin entered into Holy Matrimony with Maggie Edge and they remained faithful to each other for 73 years. Although they had no birth children of their own, together they raised 13 adopted and foster children. Pastor Jeffries committed his life to the Lord at a young age and was called into the ministry, but in 1968 he was filled with the Holy Ghost and began living a sanctified life and preaching the unadulterated gospel.

Pastor Jeffries was a farmer and share cropper in North Carolina, after farming for a whole year the owner of the farm told him that he didn't owe him anything, it was at that time Pastor and Mother Jeffries decided to move to Trenton, NJ in 1942. Pastor Jeffries was employed by Amtrak and retired from General Electric after many years of service.

Pastor Jeffries received his ministerial training at Twentieth Century Bible Institute and studied at the Church of God in Christ Bible Institute in Newark, NJ. In 1968 Pastor Jeffries began his life work as founder and pastor of Holy Nazarene Church of God in Christ; the church was founded by the leading of the Lord. Pastor Jeffries served as pastor of Holy Nazarene for 45 years, retiring in October, 2013.

Pastor Jeffries faithful served as a pastor in the Church of God in Christ New Jersey First Jurisdiction under the leaderships of Bishop Esau Courtney and Bishop Martin L. Johnson; and in the Middlesex and Courtney Memorial Districts. He was a faithful supporter of the work. Pastor Jeffries was a humble man who cared about people. He was a lover and worshiper of God. One of his last saying was, "Holiness is what I wanted, holiness is what I needed, and holiness is what I got."

Pastor Jeffries was preceded in death by his mother and father; his first wife Maggie Jeffries; his daughters Rhonda and Jacqueline Jeffries; his sons Thurman Jeffries, Aaron Connors; his sisters Mariah, Lula, Elisabeth, and Ann; his brothers Isaiah, William, Daniel, Ervin, and Alexander.

He leaves to cherish his memories his wife Clara; sons John (Aisha) Jeffries, Terrance Edwards, Albert Siegel and Kelvin (Hope) McNeil and Kenny McNeil of all of Trenton, NJ; his church family and a host relatives and friends.
